Rocky Mount, NC

Rocky Mount is a small city (about 55,000 in population), located 50 miles from Raleigh, NC. The average age of a Rocky Mount citizen is 38 and our community is rapidly growing with new housing developments for those seeking to live an area with a low cost of living.



Who We Are

Planted in 2013, Redeemer is a gospel-centered church that is committed to making disciples and planting churches. We are affiliated with Acts 29, The Summit Collaborative, and NC Baptists. Every year, we have consistently witnessed Jesus save souls, sanctify believers, and launch people on mission.

We are committed to being a missional generous people. The first 21% of every undesignated gift is given to church planting, international missions, and mercy ministry. We are also committed to growing our people in the knowledge of Christ through the preaching and teaching of Scripture. Alongside of our regulars rhythm of expository preaching through books of the Bible, we center our Life Groups around sermon based discussion and application. Additionally, we have partnered with Southeastern Baptist Theological Seminary to provide biblical training and theological education through what we call The Redeemer Institute.
