

**Instruction:** Read the text in your bible. Answer the question; there is no wrong answer. The questions are designed to help you see what God is doing in your life. Think about what God is saying to you? Ask God to reveal things to you so you can grow and share with the group.

When God is working, we must trust God to work out the details. Moses is called to lead the Hebrew people out of captivity. When Moses goes home after agreeing to work for God, he gets deathly ill because there is disobedience in his home. Moses has allowed his wife, Zipporah, to follow the Mediate tradition and skip the Hebrew tradition of circumcision of his son. Zipporah saves Moses' life by obeying God. Moses had people who loved him in his life. Let's see how Zipporah saved Moses' life.

*However, after a long time [nearly forty years] the king of Egypt died; and the Israelites were sighing and groaning because of the bondage. They kept crying, and their cry because of slavery ascended to God. Exodus 2:23 (AMP)*

**10. Disobedience brings \_\_\_\_\_.**  
*Along the way at a [resting-] place, the Lord met [Moses] and sought to kill him [made him acutely and almost fatally ill]. Exodus 4:24 (AMP)*

**11. Zipporah understood what was killing \_\_\_\_\_.**  
*[Now apparently he had failed to circumcise one of his sons, his wife being opposed to it; but seeing his life in such danger] Zipporah took a flint knife and cut off the foreskin of her son and cast it to touch [Moses'] feet, and said, Surely a husband of blood you are to me! Exodus 4:25 (AMP)*

**12. God responded to Zipporah's sacrifice \_\_\_\_\_.**  
*When He let [Moses] alone [to recover], Zipporah said, A husband of blood are you because of the circumcision. Exodus 4:26 (AMP)*
