

Let us celebrate Mothers in scripture this month. The mothers' story I want to focus on does not address how she trained her sons, but how she trained her daughter. A daughter that was not hers by birth. Naomi's story helps me ask the question what makes a great mother? Naomi is a biblical example of women who trained younger women. Naomi wanted Ruth to have a better life, so she taught her everything so she could be successful. Even when success amounted to having a family and children.
