Theme - 2021 – "Year of Goshen" "You shall dwell in the land of Goshen, and you shall be near to me, you and your children, your children's children, your flocks and your herds, and all that you have. ¶ There I will provide for you, lest you and your household, and all that you have, come to poverty; for there are still five years of famine." Genesis 45:10-11 (NKJV)

Church School Lesson: "Freed from Worry" - Scripture Text: Matthew 6:25-34 **Key Verse:** "The pagans run after all these things, and your heavenly Father knows that you need them. But seek first his kingdom and his righteousness, and all these things will be given to you as well." Matthew 6:32-33

Summary of the Lesson: Who do you trust? Each of us has a routine in life that is followed: job, home, church. The routine makes it comfortable. We know what to do next without thinking. It takes something drastic to interrupt the routine. When that happens our belief system can be shaken or cause us to question ourselves - worry. The brain is an amazing organ. It constantly provokes us to evaluate our situation and circumstance and identify threats to our well-being, even if they are minor. We may exaggerate them or imagine threats that do not exist. It opens us up to restlessness, loss of appetite, sleeplessness, short temper, a feeling of hopelessness. Each of us worry about our own survival: do we have enough food; do we have enough money; will we be able to pay the mortgage or the rent; do we have shoes and clothes. Thank God for the job or pension we have that helps us to meet our needs for survival. Do we trust God enough to know what we need and to provide what is needed? If you cannot, it means we must provide for ourselves by accumulating and hoarding possessions. The Word of God tells us not to hoard treasures down here where it gets eaten by moths and corroded by rust, or worse, stolen by burglars. Wherever your treasure is, is the place you will most want to be and end up being. It tells us to seek first the Kingdom of God. What does this mean? It means that we are to be God-focused. There is more to life than what we eat, or what we wear. God cares and gives attention to the birds of the air and the flowers of the field. Don't you think he cares more for His crown of creation, us? You can't worship two gods at once. Loving one god, you'll end up hating the other. Adoration of one feeds contempt for the other. Let us not be so preoccupied with getting, so we can respond to God's giving. Focus your life in God-reality, God initiative, God-provisions. Don't worry about missing out. You'll find all your everyday human concerns will be met. This lesson and the next several lessons reminds us what it means to have a confident hope in God. Give your entire attention to what God is doing right now, and don't get worked up about what may or may not happen tomorrow. God will help you deal with whatever hard things come up when the time comes. Who do you trust? **Amen.**
