Church School Lesson: "Delivered From Fear" - **Scripture Text:** Matthew 8:23-27 **Key Verse:** "He replied, "You of little faith, why are you so afraid?" Then he got up and rebuked the winds and the waves, and it was completely calm.

Summary of the Lesson: I could say that the lesson for today is about a group of men in a boat: twelve ordinary men and one extraordinary one. Yes, I'm over simplifying things, so let's put this in context. Jesus had been preaching, teaching, healing, casting out demons in Galilee. The twelve were witnesses to what Jesus was doing. Jesus decided He wanted to go to the other side of the lake. It would take less time to cross over in the boat than to take the long way around walking. Jesus got in the boat. His disciples followed Him. Remember the twelve chosen by Jesus were ordinary people like you and me. They professed their belief in Him, but to a point. Yes, they were the ones closest to Him, witnessing the things he said and did. Yet, in a lot of ways they were spiritually deaf. They did not understand who this extraordinary man was – not until after His death and resurrection. Without warning, a perilous situation arose – big waves, howling winds and heavy rain. They don't have life jackets and I'm sure they were worried about water filling up the boat. Surely, they would drown. And what is Jesus doing? He's sleeping! Let's stop right there! For the past 14 months, we have found ourselves in a perilous situation. While the situation is not as severe now as earlier, the death toll in the United States because of COVID19 is over 500,000 and thousands were hospitalized. We have been in a lock-down situation and are just beginning to see some of the restrictions lifted. But, not before many have lost jobs, businesses closed, homes lost. Nevertheless, we are beginning to experience some sense of normalcy. I'm sure that many who professed to believe asked whether God is sleeping. Can you imagine the grip of fear the twelve experienced? In many ways fear can become a defense mechanism. In many ways fear can become a debilitating disease. The twelve certainly thought they were going to drown. Didn't they know who was in the boat with them – that extraordinary man; that human, but yet divine man; the only One who was able to calm the raging waters by just a word? Hadn't what they had seen and heard bolster their faith at all? Apparently not. They said, get up, Jesus! Don't you care about what is happening? I'm sure we've been asking the same questions over the past 14 months: Jesus, where are you? Why did You allow so many to die? Why so many without jobs and homes? I can't answer that. But I do know that Jesus, not in human form, but His Spirit is working in the lives of the doctors, nurses, and healthcare workers; giving instructions for us to follow: wear masks, wash your hands, get vaccinated. Just as Jesus was in the boat, He is also in our midst, rebuking our waves, howling winds and rain, calming our raging sea. In the midst of a perilous situation, Jesus wants us to keep the faith, no matter what. What are you afraid of? Jesus is in the boat! Amen.
