# What is a Testimony?

A Christian testimony is the speaking, remembrance, or understanding of an everyday experience of God's love, grace, or mercy in relationship to you. A testimony and a witness are used interchangeably. However, the difference between them is that testimonies are spoken by someone who experienced a situation and a witness is someone who observed a situation. The testimony of an experience comes in many forms. Perhaps it is a lesson taught from the Bible or a reminder of something you hear. Sometimes it's the recognition of an answered prayer or the recognition of a victory over something you relate to as sin. Sometimes your Christian testimony is the way God provides extra-ordinarily in a tough situation.

There are many types of Christian testimonies or witnesses. Some are very dramatic, with wild turning points and big, "Ah-ha" moments." Some are far less so dramatic and have slow build-ups, but they are no less compelling. Some testimonies may involve great struggles and extreme stories of how God helped a person overcome them. Some Christian experiences may involve different incidents that make far more sense after reflecting on them. You may not realize something is an expression of God's relationship with you until long after the event, but when you think back, you can see the hand of God working through the situation.

# How Do I Write My Testimony?

Can you look back on an experience in your own life and recognize how God's love, grace or mercy played a part in making you better? The exercise of writing your testimony down is important for you to be able to deliver a clear testimony. It's like trying to be a bodybuilder without going to the gym. You can do it but it's just a lot harder. When you write your testimony down it helps you think about it in concrete ways. The clearer you see your testimony the easier it is to help someone else see it clearly. Writing the testimony is simply an exercise that will help you get clear.

There are three steps of writing your testimony. First state the problem or situation. Secondly, state how you believe, or perceived God's helped you. Thirdly, acknowledge the miracle. Each page has an outline you can use to draft your testimony. In addition, when you have written several testimonies, I encourage you to share this book with a leader in the faith that they could sign and confirm you as a witness for our Lord Jesus Christ.

Let this journal encourage your faith by reminding you what God has already done in your life. This journal will prepare you to testify about what you know God can do. Your testimony should be short that someone can hear it in a matter of moments, not minutes.
