- ◆ Paul's words to Timothy in 2 Timothy 1:6 are vital to our understanding. Is the Holy Spirit's work in and through us, automatic? If not, what is required of us to fulfill our calling?
- ◆ Numbers 15:31 reminds us that both the ac\_\_ and the att\_\_\_\_ one carries into being sinful needs to be dealt with. If we are not repentant, God surely will hold us accountable.
- ◆ In the end, should God treat those who bear no fruit for His Kingdom the same as those who invest their talents heartily in serving Him and His Creation?
