WHAT IS THECHURCH INTERNSHIP?

theChurch Internship is a life-changing journey that will equip you to fulfill your calling and purpose in Christ. It is designed to help you take the next step in your life as a leader, as a creative, and as a disciple of Christ.

Through 9 months of relevant teaching and mentoring on a team, you will grow in spiritual maturity. You will be trained, equipped, and empowered to be an effective leader in your personal life and at theChurch.

These classes are held on Monday evenings from 7-8:30pm. Whether you've been a Christian for a while or new to the faith, theChurch Internship will change your life.

Subjects include:

- Discipline
- Identity
- Leadership
- Purpose
- Covenant

These classes focus on covenant leadership that will prepare you to serve as a spiritual leader and to experience life transformation that will enhance and sharpen your skills and abilities with the following opportunities:

- The opportunity to strengthen your walk with God through spiritual development so that you can become a knowledgeable, devoted, and passionate disciple of Christ.
- The opportunity to explore "Covenant Life" because when you live in covenant with God and with others, you experience and enjoy your fullest potential to live your God-ordained purpose.

OUR MISSION?

To raise up transformational leaders to build and expand God's Kingdom through the Church. Becoming a fully activated person in Spirit, Soul and Body will equip you to discover your identity, live your purpose and experience your destiny.

To build His Kingdom using our spiritual gifts as we commit to the following four pillars:

Pillar #1 - A Praying Church – His command is that we pray without ceasing. (Luke 18:1, I Thessalonians 5:17, Ephesians 6:18, James 5:16)

Pillar #2 - A Giving Church – He is worthy of our time, talent, and treasure. (Acts 20:35, II Corinthians 8:5, II Corinthians 9:7, Luke 6:38)

Pillar #3 - A Serving Church – As citizens, subjects of His Kingdom, we serve Him with absolute abandonment. (John 12:26, Romans 12:11, Galatians 5:13, Romans 12:6-8)

Pillar #4 - A Witnessing Church – As ambassadors of His Kingdom, we are to share His message of salvation, healing, and deliverance with those in our world. (II Corinthians 5:19-20, Matthew 28:19-20)

WHY SHOULD I CHOOSE INTERNSHIP?

To learn from the teaching and experiences of our Senior Pastor that will be life-changing. You will experience the combined knowledge and creativity of our teams and actually get firsthand experience with our equipment and facilities that will be invaluable to you as you take your next step.

HOW LONG WILL MY INTERNSHIP LAST?

The 9-month Internship begins in September and goes until June. It includes Mondays off for holidays. Upon graduation, you will become an Intern at the Church and serve as a leader in the area you are assigned for a minimum of one year.

WHAT IS THE APPLICATION DEADLINE?

Your application is due no later than the last week of August, prior to Monday, September 9th start. An interview with the Senior Pastor will be scheduled and your application will be processed.

WILL I BE ON MY OWN?

You will be given responsibility and will be working alongside our teams. You should always be willing and available to do whatever is needed in the ministry.

WHAT IS THE COURSE OF STUDY FOR THE INTERNSHIP PROGRAM?

Discipline, Identity, Leadership, Purpose, and Covenant. After each course of study, a summary paper will be due on what you have comprehended from that particular subject. Additional assignments are given during the class times. You will be responsible for filling out a weekend report at each class.

theChurch Internship Training Qualifications

1. You must have completed Growth Track at theChurch or plan to do so in September.
2. Be a Member of theChurch, after completing Growth Track.
3. Sign the Honor Code.
4. Tithe and give to theChurch regularly.
5. Be Water Baptized.
6. Be currently serving on a ministry team of theChurch.

COVENANT COMMITMENT:

Commit to serve the mission and statement of faith of theChurch and commit to the Senior Pastor to attend class every week during the Internship.

You will be held to a high standard of leadership, integrity and character.

Two-week limit for excused absences for classes to graduate.

Three worship service limit for absences on the weekends to graduate.

Commit to abide by the Leadership Honor Code, commit to serve with integrity and passion, commit to tithing 10% of your income, commit to attend all-church prayer and to personal Bible study and prayer.

Upon graduation you will become an Intern of theChurch and continue to serve for a period no less than one year.

REQUIREMENTS:

Internship participants are required to serve a service and worship a service on weekends and to sit up front and take notes. Weekly weekend reports are to be submitted each Monday at class.

You are required to bring your Bible and notebook to class each week and have taken time to study, and put into practice, the previous week's lesson notes.

You are asked to check your text messages and emails on a daily basis and respond within 24-48 hours to messages from theChurch. This is how we will communicate during the duration of the class.

If you are accepted into theChurch's Internship, we ask that you only involve yourself totally into this study and not be involved in any other studies outside the ministry of theChurch.

DRESS CODE:

Leadership is dressing on a professional level which means attire should be dressy casual, modern, contemporary.

Leadership Honor Code

The *Honor Code* embodies the essence of which we choose to be and how we choose to live. Biblical principles of integrity, love for God and respect for social and spiritual laws are the basis of these statements. Our goal is to help you honor God in every area of your life; to grow spiritually, academically, physically and socially. As a leader, you will be asked to abide by these established standards. We take them seriously and expect you to do the same.

As an essential part of the theChurch's leadership, you have a responsibility to develop and exhibit mature Christian behavior. This should be the basic premise of your desire to participate in a leadership position here at theChurch.

While serving the Body of Christ, you pledge to present a good appearance at all times. In both attire and behavior, you should strive to demonstrate Biblical standards in all situations.

As Christians, the way we present ourselves to others is of vital importance to the way others perceive Christ. Our conduct should never be an embarrassment to Christ, but should exemplify the best qualities of a mature believer and servant-leader.

Exemplifying the highest moral commitment, theChurch's Interns are to maintain a disciplined life of Bible reading and prayer. You must also refrain from such things as:
