Responsibilities and Requirements:

- 4. Serving and influencing others to participate in serving our community through student ministry sponsored serving opportunities.

Impact Team Specific:

- 1. I will attend the weekly Student Impact meeting. If I cannot be at meeting for some reason, I must call the Student Impact leader. You get two skips per semester so choose your skips wisely.
- 2. I will provide constructive criticism and feedback for student ministry activities which is important in building a student ministry that effectively serves students.
- 3. Memorize scripture and complete assigned readings as given.
- 4. Participate on Serving Teams: Welcome Team, Set Up Team, Clean Up Team, etc.
- 5. Participate with Wednesday nights (announcements, greeting, etc) as needed and desired.
- 6. Work with small group leader to make disciples

Worship/Tech Team Specific:

- 1. Show up when expected for rehearsal, I will not bail last minute after accepting the request to serve. If you are a no show there will be disciplinary action.
- I will respond to the request to serve in a timely manner. Failure to respond by the Monday before the scheduled Wednesday night Elevate will be seen as a no to the request.
- 3. Put in time outside of rehearsal to learn, memorize, and know the flow of the music. (Everyone)
- 4. Know how to play with a click track (metronome). (Band)
- 5. Learn how to use the equipment in the tech booth. Ask questions if you do not know (tech)
- 6. Show up to rehearsal 10-15 minutes before the scheduled time to start so that we may start on time. If you know ahead of time that you will be late to rehearsal you must communicate that with the Worship Director, and you may be asked to not play that week.
- 7. Be at early rehearsal when scheduled at 4:15 (vocalist) and ready to go for main rehearsal by 5:00 (everyone).
