Impact Team Specific:

1. I will attend the weekly Student Impact meeting. If I cannot be at meeting for some reason, I must call the Student Impact leader. You get two skips per semester so choose your skips wisely.
2. I will provide constructive criticism and feedback for student ministry activities. This is important in building a student ministry that effectively serves students.
3. Memorize scripture and complete assigned readings as given.
4. You are expected to be at Elevate by 5pm every Wednesday to help set up and pray for the evening. If you are on the worship team that evening, you are excused. All other excused absences needs to be approved by Greg.
5. Be actively engaged and supportive in small group.

Worship/Tech Team Specific:

1. Be at early rehearsal when scheduled at 4:15 (vocalist) and ready to go for main rehearsal by 5:00 (everyone). I will not bail last minute after accepting the request to serve. If you are a no show, there will be disciplinary action.
2. Show up to rehearsal 15 minutes before the scheduled time to start so that we may start on time. If you know ahead of time that you will be late to rehearsal you must communicate that with the Worship Director, and you may be asked to not play that week.
3. Put in time outside of rehearsal to learn and know the flow of the music. (Everyone)
4. Know how to play with a click track (metronome). (Band)
5. Continue to grow in your knowledge and skill or your instrument. Ask questions if you need help.
