2. Modeling a healthy commitment to my family, my peers and my school.
3. Personal growth through Bible study and prayer. I will pray for my friends, family, other students, and student ministry adult leaders. ***This is of utmost importance***
4. Show up when expected for rehearsal, I will not bail last minute after accepting the request to serve. If you are a no show there will be disciplinary action.
5. A lifestyle befitting one who is a role model and an ambassador of Christ.
6. I will be willing and prepared to seek out ministry opportunities. It is my responsibility to see that new students are welcomed, and that all students feel loved and encouraged.
7. I will respond to the request to serve in a timely manner. Failure to respond by the Monday before the scheduled Wednesday night Elevate will be seen as a no to the request.

8. I will make student ministry activities a priority. It's important that as a member of the Worship/Tech Team, that I support activities taking place. I recognize that if I, as a leader, do not place high value on what we do in student ministry, it will be that much more difficult for my peers to do the same.
9. I am committed to learning what it means to be a leader, influencing others, and growing in order to impact my community.
10. I am committed to growing in the ways of the Lord through prayer and quiet times.
11. I will maintain a list of more than five people that are my peers who do not know Jesus and will remain committed to build a relationship with them to share the Gospel.

Worship/Tech Team Responsibilities and Requirements:

1. Attending the IMPACT Development Retreat in the August
2. Attend summer Student Ministry large event (Challenge, Student Life, mission trip)
3. Attend mid-year retreat such as D Now.
4. Serving and influencing others to participate in serving our community through student ministry sponsored serving opportunities.
5. Put in time outside of rehearsal to learn, memorize, and know the flow of the music. (Everyone)
6. Know how to play with a click track (metronome). (Band)
7. Have at least one year of lessons under my belt. (Musicians, not necessarily vocalist)
8. Learn how to use the equipment in the tech booth. Ask questions if you do not know (tech)
9. Show up to rehearsal 10-15 minutes before the scheduled time to start so that we may start on time. If you know ahead of time that you will be late to rehearsal you must communicate that with the Worship Director, and you may be asked to not play that week.
10. Be at early rehearsal when scheduled at 4:15 (vocalist) and ready to go for main rehearsal by 5:00 (everyone).
