YOU MUST GO IN ORDER!! (Example: #1 Books of the Bible memorized & recited **BEFORE** #2 Proverbs 3:3-6; or Galatians 5:13-6:10 read and report completed **BEFORE** Psalms 91 is started.)

The **FINAL** deadline to turn in all Camp Buck work is Wednesday, June 9th!
