COVID-19 Guidelines

We are so excited to finally be meeting with your children in person! Here are the guidelines we will be following to care for your children and our volunteers:

Masks:

- As a policy that is mandatory at FBC, and given that we want to be good stewards of their building and policies, children [two years old and up](#) will be required to wear masks. We understand that this is not an easy endeavor, but our volunteers will gently encourage and help the little ones to keep them on during CommKids.
- All leaders, teachers, and other adult volunteers will wear masks.
- All parents entering the building will wear masks.

Entry and Exit:

- Bringing your child to CommKids activities indicates that your child is fever-free (temperature lower than 100° when they were medicine free for at least 24 hours) and has no other sign of illness: cough, runny nose, rash, etc..
- Temperatures will be taken prior to admittance in the CommKids area for volunteers, children, and parents.
- At the classroom door: Sign-in, signing in also acknowledges your agreement with the Covid statement at the top of the sign-in page. Sign-out your child at pick-up.
- Stay to the left side of the hallway unless crossing over to pick up your child.
- Form a social distanced line outside the classroom to drop off and pick up your child.
- Refrain from gathering in the hallways and please save connecting with friends for after you leave the building.

Classrooms:

Classrooms will be sanitized before each new session.

Hand sanitizer will be available for children who enter the room.

[The Crawlers & Cruisers](#) environment will be arranged to encourage individual play.

[The Two Year Olds](#) will be provided their own classroom supplies (crayons, markers, paper, craft materials, etc.) that will be stored at the church for them.

The classroom environments, including tables and chairs as well as learning stations, will be set to encourage social distancing. Materials will be swapped out for fresh ones as each child rotates.

Other:

No personal articles, including jackets and diaper bags, will be allowed in the classrooms.
No snacks or drinks will be given.
Bathroom use and diaper changes are encouraged before entering the classrooms.
