Scripture for Reflection and Preparation

Psalms 63:1-3

- Remind you of His great love for you
- Draw you close to Himself
- Refresh your spirit
- Renew your spiritual joy

Pray for Personal Spiritual Revival

Longing for His Word

God's Word is an indispensable part of genuine, lasting revival.

Preparation

- Praise God for who He is
- Confess your sinfulness and need for cleansing
- Allow His Spirit to draw you near
- Listen as He speaks to you

Ask God to...

- Give you a deeper longing to walk with Him
- Reveal Himself to you as you read His Word
- Help you apply the truths in His Word to your life
- Show you areas of your life that need to be surrendered to Him
- Help you realize the depth of His love as you read His Word
- Help you trust Him more as you learn more about Him from His Word

AUGUST 31, 2021

Scripture for Reflection and Preparation

Psalms 119:36-40

Turn my heart to Your decrees and not to material gain. Turn my eyes from looking at what is worthless; give me life in Your ways. Confirm what You said to Your servant, for it produces reverence for You. Turn away the disgrace I dread; indeed, Your judgments are good.

SEPTEMBER 1, 2021

Scripture for Reflection and Preparation

Psalms 51:10-12

Philippians 1:9-11

Self-Examination

Preparation

- Help you be honest with Him about your sin
- Fill you with a deep desire for holiness
- Help you hate the sin in your life
- Help you surrender sinful thoughts and practices
- Help you live more faithfully
- Restore any lost joy in your walk with Him

SEPTEMBER 2, 2021

Pray for Personal Spiritual Revival

Examine Relationships

Christians must seek to restore healthy relationships.

Preparation

- Praise God for who He is
- Confess your sinfulness and need for cleansing
- Allow His Spirit to draw you near
- Listen as He speaks to you

Ask God to...

- Show you if you have any broken relationships in your life
- Help you know if you have contributed to broken relationships
- Help you determine to do all you can to mend broken relationships
- Help those you have hurt to forgive you
- Restore your fellowship with them
- Give you the courage to seek to restore fellowship
- Help you be a peacemaker whenever possible

Scripture for Reflection and Preparation

Ephesians 4:25-27

Since you put away lying, speak the truth, each one to his neighbor, because we are members of one another. Be angry and do not sin. Don't let the sun go down on your anger, and don't give the Devil an opportunity.

John 13:34-35

I give you a new commandment; love one another. Just as I have loved you, you must also love one another. By this all people will know that you are My disciples, if you have love for one another.

Colossians 3:12-15

Therefore, God's chosen ones, holy and loved, put on heartfelt compassion, kindness, humility, gentleness, and patience, accepting one another and forgiving one another if anyone has a complaint against another. Just as the Lord has forgiven you, so also you must forgive. Above all, put on love - the perfect bond of unity. SEPTEMBER 3, 2021

Scripture for Reflection and Preparation

Isaiah 55:10-11

For just as rain and snow fall from heaven, and do not return there without; saturating the earth, and making it germinate and sprout, and providing seed to sow and food to eat, so My word that comes from My mouth will not return to Me empty, but it will accomplish what I please, and will prosper in what I send it to do.

Luke 10:2

Matthew 28:18-20

Then Jesus came near and said to them, 'All authority has been given to Me in heaven and on earth. Preparation

- Praise God for who He is
- Confess your sinfulness and need for cleansing
- Allow His Spirit to draw you near
- Listen as He speaks to you

Ask God to...

- Help you understand more about the plight of the lost
- Help you understand better how much He abhors sin
- Give you a greater understanding of His holiness
- Give you a renewed burden for the lost
- Help you share His message of love with the lost
- Save the lost people you will pray for right now
- Lead you to more lost people to witness to

Pray for Personal Spiritual Revival

Repentance

Revival begins when Christians repent of their sin and embrace holiness.

Preparation

- Praise God for who He is
- Confess your sinfulness and need for cleansing
- Allow His Spirit to draw you near
- Listen as He speaks to you

Ask God to...

- Help you surrender every area of your life to Christ's lordship
- Help you be aware of any sin in your life
- Help you be willing to give up sin in your life
- Help you change any patterns in your life that tempt you to sin
- Help you make strong Christian friendships that encourage you in holiness
- Help you live faithfully
- Help you to be an example of holiness to others

SEPTEMBER 4, 2021

Scripture for Reflection and Preparation

1 John 1:9

If we confess our sins, He is faithful and righteous to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.

Mark 1:15

The time is fulfilled, and the kingdom of God has come near. Repent and believe in the good news.

Luke 13:1-5

At that time, some people came and reported to Him about the Galileans whose blood Pilate had mixed with their sacrifices. And He responded to them, 'Do you think that these Galileans were more sinful than all Galileans because they suffered these things? No, I tell you; but unless you repent, you will all perish as well! Or those that the tower in Siloam fell on and killed - do you think they were more sinful than all the people who live in Jerusalem? No, I tell you; but unless you repent, you will all perish as well.'

SEPTEMBER 5, 2021

Scripture for Reflection and Preparation

Matthew 5:13-16

You are the salt of the earth. But if the salt should lose its taste, how can it be made salty? It's no longer good for anything but to be thrown out and trampled on by men. You are the light of the world. A city situated on a hill cannot be hidden. No one lights a lamp and puts it under a basket, but rather on a lampstand, and it gives light for all who are in the house. In the same way, let your light shine before men, so that they may see your good works and give glory to your Father in heaven.

1 Timothy 2:1-4

First of all, then, I urge that petitions, prayers, intercessions, and thanksgivings be made for everyone, for kings and all those who are in authority, so that we may lead a tranquil and quiet life in all godliness and dignity. This is good, and it pleases God our Savior, who wants everyone to be saved and to come to the knowledge of the truth.
