

# CHURCH AT HOME 3.29.20

Moses wrote in the Psalms, “teach us to number our days, so that we may get a heart of wisdom.” Jesus “knowing his hour had come” (v.1,3), he got low and washed his disciple’s feet... We may have a bucket list and we may also have an idea of what we want our of life to look like... but with the breath you have now, and with the day that has been given to you today... Jesus calls us to be washed by His love and grace, to serve, to forgive one another, and to love one another just as He has loved us (v.34-35).

Do you have a fear about your “number of days?”  
Reflect on the powerful lyrics to the song *In Christ Alone*, what is your response?

*“No guilt in life, no fear in death,  
This is the power of Christ in me  
From life's first cry to final breath,  
Jesus commands my destiny  
No power of hell, no scheme of man,  
Can ever pluck me from His hand  
Till He returns or calls me home  
Here in the power of Christ I'll stand.”*

Peter was, at first, resistant to Jesus washing his feet. We have a tendency to resist God’s grace. Do you see this in your life?
