God's Power transforms us to pursue His will and mission.

Wayne Grudem - Omnipotence (Power, Sovereignty). God's omnipotence means that God is able to do all his holy will.

1Chronicles 29:11-12

God has Unlimited Power.

God cannot do certain things. God cannot lie, sin, deny himself, or be tempted with evil. He cannot cease to exist, or cease to be God, or act in a way inconsistent with any of his attributes. Titus 1:2; 2Timothy 2:13; James 1:13

God has overwhelming Power. Psalm 33:6; Jeremiah 32:17

God has Unimaginable Power.

- Inconceivable
- God has the power to save people who cannot save themselves. Romans 3:23; 6:23; Romans 1:16-17
- Remember Jesus' encounter with the Rich Young Ruler. Matt 19:16-30; Zephaniah 3:17
- Job 42:2; Isaiah 14:27; Isaiah 43:13

God has Everlasting Power. Isaiah 40:28, 30-31; 2 Cor 12:9

How can we live and receive the Power of God in our lives?

Eph 3:20 Now to him who is able to do immeasurably more than all we ask or imagine, according to His Power that is at work within us,

God's Power comes from Repentance and Prayer, resulting in Peace. Phil 4:4-7 – Peace of God.

God's Power comes from Thinking like the Lord. Phil 4:8; 1Cor 2:16

God's Power comes from being content in the strength of the Lord. Phil 4:11-13

God's Power meets all our needs for His Glory. Phil 4:19-20

God wants to revive his people, so they experience his daily Power in their lives. Where do you need to see God's Power in your life today?
