
DAY 6

DAY 1

I pray that God, the source of hope, will fill you completely with joy and peace because you trust in him. Then you will overflow with confident hope through the power of the Holy Spirit. Romans 15:13 NLT

All of my peers are also stressed any time they are left alone with their thoughts. However, while I definitely worry sometimes, I understand that no matter what the admission office says, God's plan will be good. 
Today, think about the fact that God wants to be close to you. How does that bring you peace?

What are some worries and cares that you can give to God today?


DAY 5
