Delight in The Word as you read!

Next, reach the weary. Memorize God’s salvation plan so that you will “be ready always to give an answer to every man.” Listen and learn The Gospel Presentation from the message that was posted on the church website for December 27, 2020. This will help you become comfortable in sharing the gospel with a lost, weary world.

Any time is a good time to share Jesus but especially during this troubled time of pandemic and politics. Being in The Word will provide wisdom to win the lost. Remember, “He that winneth souls is wise.” (Proverbs 11:30)
