Spring is always filled with church & youth group weekends, various outside groups renting the facilities, and pre-summer planning meetings. The end of May we welcomed **Ten2** participants for a week-long orientation.



This program is a revamp of the program I first came with over 40 years ago. It was a great way to kick off the summer with

over 100 people on the property. 84 students are now serving 8 weeks at various ministry sites across Europe. Our prayer is that many of these young people will return to Europe as full-time missionaries.

While Ten2 was here, our 25-year-old dish washer stopped working, right in the middle of a French holiday weekend. We quickly created dish washing stations and began doing dishes "the old-fashioned way," by hand. As you can imagine, this was a great bonding experience, since the normal dish washing time of 35-45 minutes quickly turned into an hour and a half adventure. Even though some people were doing dishes by hand for the first time in their lives, the participants loved it. Not so much for the work itself, but for the experience of facing a challenge as a team. Our interns, **Matt & Cam** (in the center of the picture below) were responsible for training a new dish and clean-up crew every day.



### GOD'S PROVISION

Through the gifts of many faithful donors, we were able to purchase a new oven that has twice the capacity of our old one. The old oven was 25 years old and was starting to have some serious issues. The new oven is great, and should serve us well into the future.



As we began some long-term remodeling projects on our older buildings, we were able to purchase a new tractor. We had to say good-bye to our old yellow tractor that served us so well for over 40 years.
