It doesn't mean we don't face challenges here as well, but they are far outweighed by the excitement we get from one conversation about how amazing our God is.

Nicole finished her two month intensive of the language. During that two months she had many opportunities to literally share the gospel in that classroom. A response to following Jesus from a woman from Turkey who is a practicing Muslim was, "Wow! That sounds nice.". YES! It is so nice. God is up to big things. Pray for the many relationships Nicole has been able to make while being here for a little less than three months.

Tate has now begun his language classes and in the short time it has begun he has also had the opportunity to share about the history of the Bible, his beliefs, and who Jesus is. Sometimes it's the little things that are opening doors. Scripture on a Tate's phone screen saver, for example begun an entire conversation. Bibles are an odd thing to see here so when someone sees it out it really brings a lot of questions. We try to make a point to always have our physical Bible with us, more than we ever did in the States.

Another big thing we need prayers for is that we have been given the chance to teach a one-on-one English conversational class. We will meet with our students once a week and also offer them an extra time to meet to go through a small Bible study to continue to improve their English. Tate has also been told he could be teaching a class of up to ten and Nicole will be doing the same for the next semester. We did not expect this opportunity, we did not go looking for it, but here it is. Please, please pray for us and our students.

Thank you for sending us. This is exactly where our family is meant to be. Pray God keeps moving. Pray for our family. Pray for safety. Pray for our marriage. Pray we stay strong and connected with God. Pray for this fire to keep us moving, but not let us burn out. We know that all of those things need to stay strong in order for our ministry here to flourish and be fruitful.
