We believe that serving at Kamp Kidville is more than a summer job--it is a calling. Is God calling you to serve at Kamp Kidville?

At Kamp Kidville, it is our desire to be obedient to God's Word and to selflessly provide an environment that encourages children to experience the grace, hope and love of Jesus Christ through curriculum that is fun and in an environment that is safe. It is our prayer that lives will be eternally impacted, and children will develop a desire to take that step of faith to become followers of Christ.

Hiring is based first on the applicant's spiritual, mental and emotional maturity plus his or her ability to relate to children. Second, the applicants will be evaluated on their ability to be supervised by peers of close age and their ability to work together as a team. Third, the applicants' skills, talents, and types of experiences will be assessed.

KEY INFORMATION TO KNOW BEFORE APPLYING:

- Kamp Kidville runs June 6 to July 29, Monday through Friday, 7:30 a.m. to 5:30 p.m.
 We will be closed on Monday, July 4.
- All applicants will be allow a maximum of 5 days off for the entire summer.
- ♦ Mandatory Training dates are June 1, 2 & 3.
- Online CPR training must be completed by May 31.

WHAT DO WE LOOK FOR IN A KAMP KIDVILLE GROUP LEADER? A PERSON WHO:

- Puts God first, children second, and staff third
- Maintains a consistent daily effort to further his/her relationship with Christ
- ♦ Shows children God's love throughout each day through words and actions
- Shares the Gospel with children
- ♦ Serves wholeheartedly and sacrificially
- Teaches and participates in all aspects of camp with enthusiasm, excitement, and energy
- Possesses the physical and mental ability to participate in all Kamp Kidville activities
- Has the capacity to accept supervision and guidance from peers of close age
- Shows accountability to Kamp Kidville and First Baptist Church policy
- Exhibits the maturity to maintain physical, mental, and spiritual health by realizing that the demands of this job require proper rest and nourishment on a daily basis
- Desires to work together as a cohesive team at Kamp Kidville, a team consists of group leaders, management staff, and church ministers
- Chooses to refrain from gossiping and avoids negativity toward camp staff and management

ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS OF A GROUP LEADER:

- Supervise campers, know their whereabouts, and insure their safety at all times
- Set a good example for campers and others throughout each day, including things like cleanliness, sharing clean-up duties, sportsmanship, and something as simple as table manners
- Punctuality in every aspect of camp
- ♦ Lead and participate with campers in all activities throughout each day making camp fun while teaching skills and providing opportunities for each camper to experience success while at camp
- ◆ Teach the provided curriculum such as Bible study, arts and crafts, and culinary activities as directed
- Remain with campers at all times unless otherwise instructed by management staff
- Identify the needs of each camper, and facilitate age-appropriate, problem-solving techniques
- Respect each camper for their uniqueness; within each group help create a sense of community which will emphasize communication and teamwork
- Recognize and respond to opportunities for group problem solving
- Observe camper behavior, assess its appropriateness, enforce appropriate safety regulations and emergency procedures, and apply appropriate behavior management techniques
- Recognize the signs and symptoms of bullying and take appropriate action as spelled out in training
- Follow the Kamp Kidville discipline matrix
- Encourage and demonstrate respect for personal property, camp equipment, and church facilities
- Support and assist management staff and instructors at all times
- Demonstrate a positive rapport with supervisors, peers and children on a daily basis
- ♦ Communicate with Program Director and CLC Director regarding concerns, updates, and challenges
