



## CONVERSATION

### Noah Built the Ark

GENESIS 6:9–9:17

God saw that the people on earth were thinking and doing evil things. God knew that Noah was always a good man who made right choices. Noah pleased God. He had a wife and three sons. God told Noah He would bring a flood to destroy everything on earth.

God gave Noah detailed instructions on how to build an ark. God said He would keep Noah and his family safe. God told Noah to bring every kind of living creature, male and female, on the ark. God told him to take food for Noah's family and the animals. Noah did everything God commanded. Noah obeyed God and built the ark. It took Noah at least 100 years to build the ark. God brought the animals to Noah.

When it was time, Noah and his family entered the ark. God shut the door. Noah was 600 years old when the flood began. For 40 days and 40 nights water burst from the earth and rain fell from the sky. The ark floated on the surface of the waters. The water rose and covered the whole earth, but God provided for Noah, his family, and the animals. Five months after the flood began, the ark came to rest on the mountains of Ararat. Noah sent out a raven which flew back-and-forth until the water dried up. Then Noah sent out a dove. It came back because there was no dry place for it to rest. After seven days, Noah sent out the dove again. This time the dove returned with an olive leaf. Seven days later, Noah sent out the dove again. When the dove did not come back, Noah knew the waters had gone down. The day came that God told Noah it was time to come out of the ark. Noah immediately built an altar to worship God. God was pleased, and blessed Noah and his family. God made a covenant promise that He never again would send a flood to destroy the earth. God placed a rainbow in the clouds as a reminder of His promise with all living creatures of the earth.
