## CONVERSATION

### Jesus Prayed in a Garden

MARK 14:32-40; LUKE 22:39-46

In a garden named Gethsemane, Jesus told His disciples to wait while He went apart from them and prayed. He took Peter, James, and John further into the garden with Him. As Jesus prayed, He was suffering and troubled. He asked Peter, James, and John to wait while He went further into the garden. “Stay awake and keep watch,” Jesus told them.

Jesus fell to the ground. He prayed, asking God that the hard things He must do be taken away. Jesus said, “Father, You can do anything. Take this hard time away from Me. But don’t do what I want. Do what You want.”

Jesus found the disciples sleeping. “Simon,” he said to Peter, “are you asleep? Could you not stay awake for one hour?” Jesus said, “Pray that you will not give in to temptation.”

Again, Jesus went away and prayed.

Jesus found the disciples sleeping again. They did not know what to say to Him.

Luke told the same story about Jesus praying in the garden in the Gospel he wrote. Luke added that an angel came to Jesus and strengthened Him to do what He must do.

**WEEKLY BIBLE VERSE:** 1 John 5:14

**LIFE POINT:** God can lead us to pray for His will as Jesus did.



#### THE BIBLE MEETS LIFE

Parents, today’s Bible story taught your child that God can lead us to pray for His will as Jesus did. Before Jesus was crucified, He prayed in the garden for God to give Him strength to carry out God’s will.

#### LIVE IT OUT

Work with your child to memorize the Weekly Bible Verse, 1 John 5:14. Help her understand that praying for specific things is not wrong, but we should always pray for God’s will to be done, just as Jesus prayed before His crucifixion.
