SERVICE SCHEDULE

We will continue to offer two opportunities to worship on Sunday mornings at 8:30am and 10:50am.

SEATING

Beginning Sunday, March 14, the section in front of the AV Booth on the south side of the Worship Center will be designated for anyone who would like to continue to social distance. The other sections in the Worship Center will be completely opened.

WORSHIP ONLINE

Our online worship services will continue to be made available via Facebook, Youtube, firstcelina.org, and our church app (available for iOS and Android). We will be streaming the 10:50am only and will be live 10 minutes prior to service starting.

SANITIZING & CLEANING

We are taking extra steps in sanitizing and cleaning our facilities. The restrooms, doors, and other high traffic areas are getting extra attention weekly. We are also cleaning and sanitizing pews between services so you are more confident in worshipping in-person.

MASKS UPDATE

Beginning Sunday, March 14, masks and face coverings in *all* areas of our campus will be ***optional***.

TEMPERATURE CHECKS & WAIVERS

Temperature checks and signed waivers are no longer required for children staying for Connect Groups, KidsTime, or Wednesday Night AWANA.

CHILDCARE UPDATE

KidsTime for Preschool will continued to be offered during the 10:50am service only. Families can register online to continue to help us with how many preschoolers to expect. Beginning Sunday, March 14, KidsTime for K-2nd Grade will be offered during the 10:50am service only. There is no registration required and children will be dismissed after the music portion of the service.

PRESCHOOL & CHILDREN'S CHECK-IN

Temperature checks and waivers will no longer be required for preschool children's check-in. Check-In will take place in the regular check-in areas. Masks and face coverings will be ***optional***.

SUNDAY NIGHTS

All regularly scheduled Sunday night activities will resume in the Fall.
