

# Preschool Protocol

## Infants-4's

We are so thankful for the privilege and blessing of being able to care for children here at First Celina. Keeping children safe is of utmost importance to us. Thank you in advance for your understanding and patience as we adopt new practices to accomplish this. We know that these guidelines and precautions are tedious, however they are not optional.

### You should NOT come into the building if:

1. anyone in your household has a fever of 100 degrees or higher.
2. anyone in your household has any respiratory infections, or have had a cough, sneezing regularly, had shortness of breath, vomiting or diarrhea within the last 24 hours.
3. in the previous 14 days, anyone in your household has had any contact with someone: with a confirmed diagnosis of Covid-19; is under the investigation for Covid-19 or is ill experiencing a respiratory illness.
4. in the previous 14 days, anyone in your household has traveled on a cruise or internationally.

All staff, adults and children will have their temperatures taken upon arrival (touchless thermometer) and will be screened with the four statements above. If anyone in your household has a temperature of 100 or higher upon arrival, your child will not be allowed to stay. If a fever develops during their time in the classroom, the child will be removed from other children and parents will be called for pickup.

### Drop off and Pickup Procedures:

- Each child must have a reservation to be admitted into the preschool area.
- Everyone's temperature will be taken upon entering the preschool area.
- Please take your child to the restroom before checking in.
- Families will be asked to line up in the preschool area spaced at least 6 feet apart from other families. There will be markers spaced out on the floor and families are asked to gather around them as they move toward the front of the line.
- Families will enter the preschool lobby and exit out the back doors of the preschool area. Traffic in the hallway will all head in the same direction.
- Please be prompt in picking up your child after the service so that we can quickly sanitize the rooms.

### Preschool Area Procedures:

- Hand sanitizer will be located at the entrances for our employees and everyone's protection.
- No diaper bags/tote bags of any sort should be sent with your children. If you need to send supplies or a change of clothes, please bring them in a clear Ziploc bag labeled with your child's name and instructions.
- Those children who are still using bottles or sippy cups may have a second Ziploc bag with written instructions provided for the teacher.
- Twos and older will be given a backpack with their own set of crayons and markers. It would be very helpful if you can make sure that these are brought with them each Sunday.
- Staff and children will be required to wash their hands upon arriving in a classroom. Teachers will prompt children to wash their hands regularly while in the classroom.
- Greeters/screeners will wear masks. Classroom teachers have the option to wear masks if they prefer.
- Teachers wear gloves when diapering and follow good hand washing hygiene. Changing tables will be cleaned and sanitized after each use. These are already practiced procedures.
- The playground will be closed.
