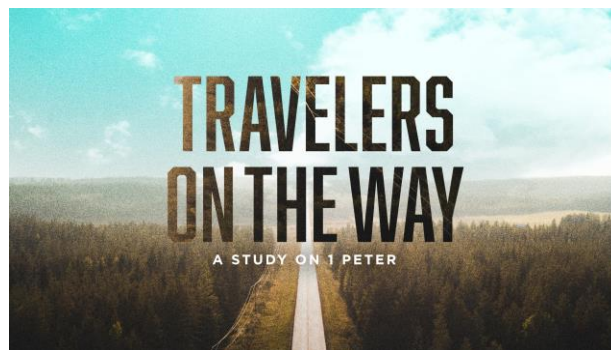

Travelers on the Way: Resolved to Suffer

- I. Fighting for freedom from sin starts with a right resolve. (v. 1-2)
 - a. The right resolve involves:
 - i. A willingness to obey God
 - ii. Even if it means suffering for me
 - b. The right resolve includes:
 - i. A mind that is resolved.
 - ii. A heart that will act.
- II. Fitting in ought to be foreign to our faith. (v. 3-4)
 - a. There may have been a time in our lives when we swam in the river of rebellion.
 - b. When we choose the will of God, the world won't understand.
- III. Finding the right resolve is rooted in seeing past the present. (v. 5-6)
 - a. All of us will have to answer for our actions.
 - b. While death has its due, the good news is that through the gospel God gives us the good life.
