Acts 2:42-47

- I. The movement of God created the church, which became the embodiment of God's mission.
 - a. The church of Acts 2 is:
 - i. Committed to God, Biblical theology, and to prayer.
 - ii. Unified by doctrine and in living.
 - iii. Amazed by God's active and providential working in our lives.
 - iv. Generous with our time, money, and possessions.
 - v. Consistent with our presence and in our beliefs and our practice.
 - vi. Grateful for God's provision and His people.
 - vii. Known by the community as different.
 - viii. Growing in depth (discipleship) and width (evangelism).
- II. How can we participate in the movement of God here at Ridgecrest?
 - a. We can participate by:
 - i. Knowing God through personal commitment to our devotional time, corporately gathering to worship, and relational discipleship in our life groups.
 1. It is our shared knowledge of who God is that created the unity of the church.
 - ii. Serving others with our time, money, possessions, and presence.
 1. It is our generous and grateful service to our families, to one another, and to our community that will lead to being seen favorably by those outside.
 - iii. Reaching our world, fueled by the gratitude and awe of God.
