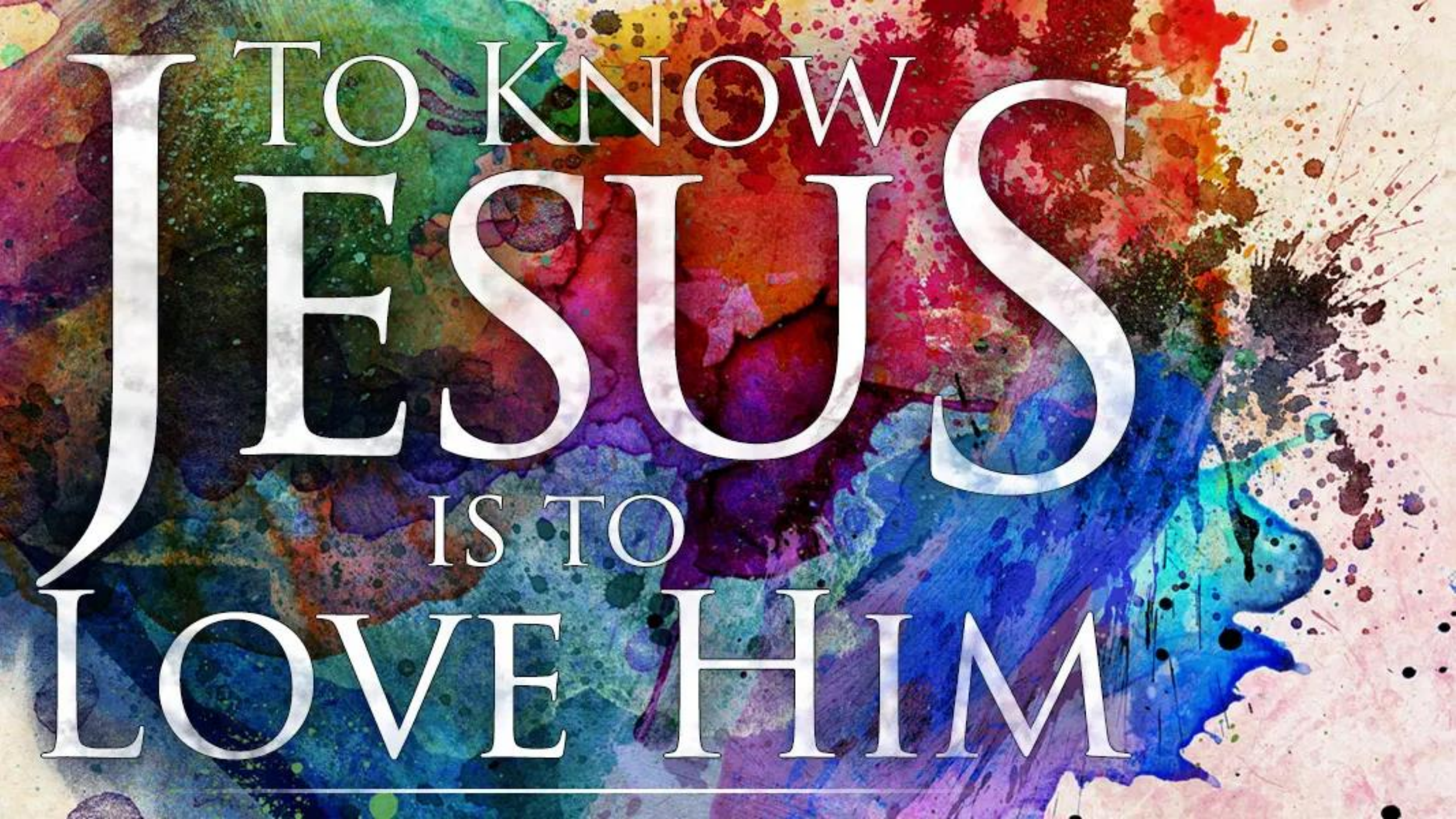

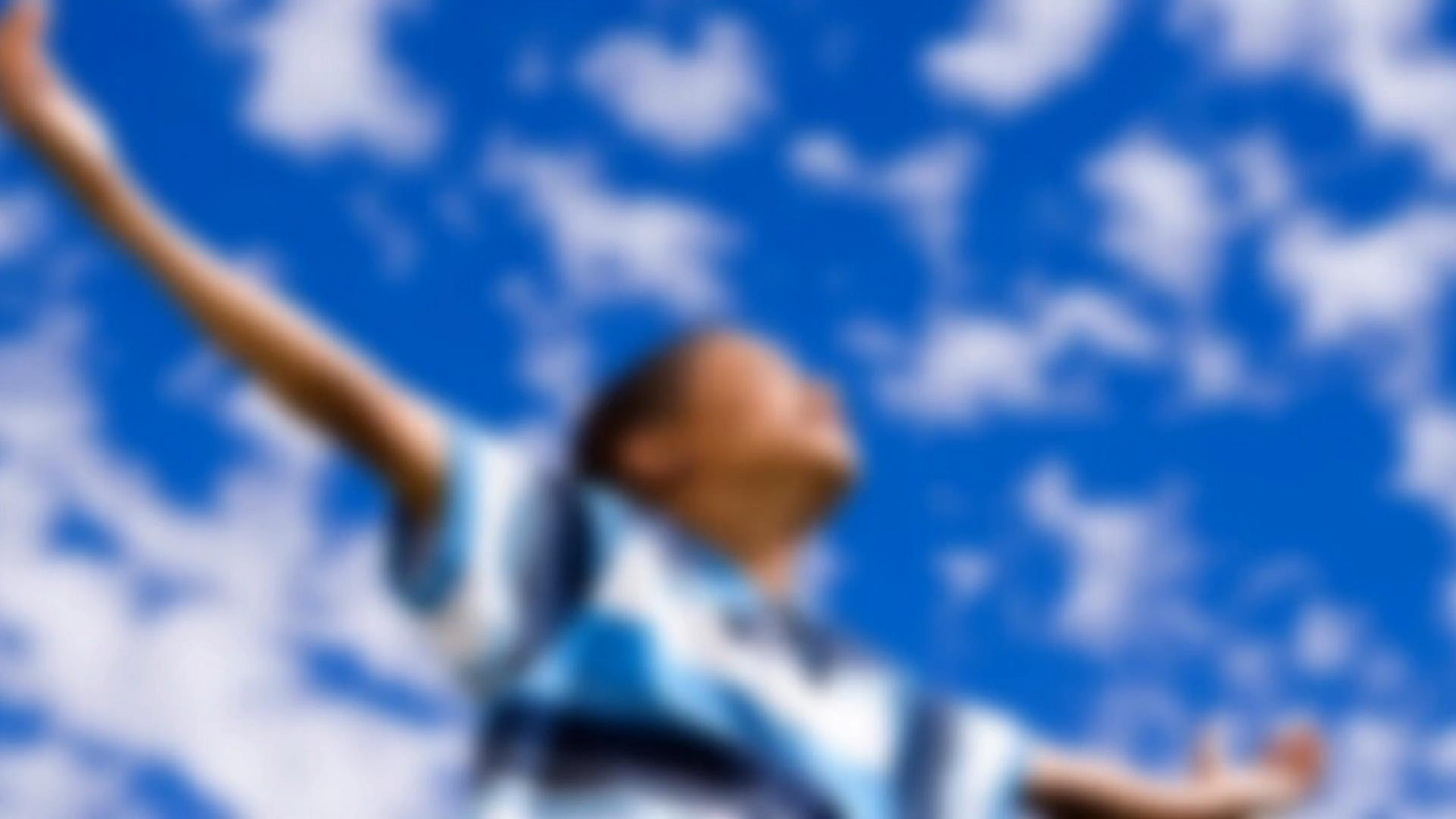

# Apostle Paul

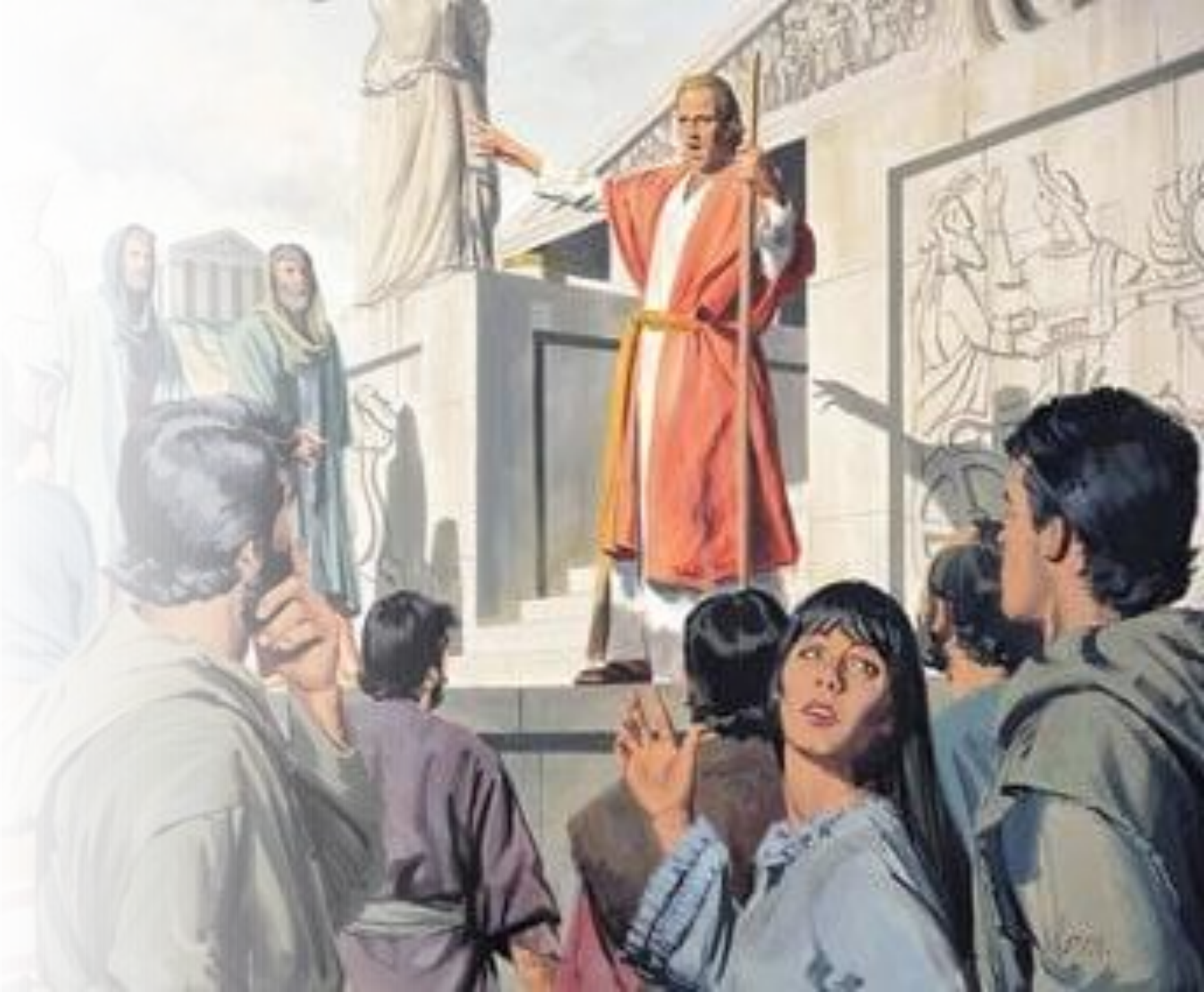




Apostle Paul
