19 And if they were all one member, where would be the body?

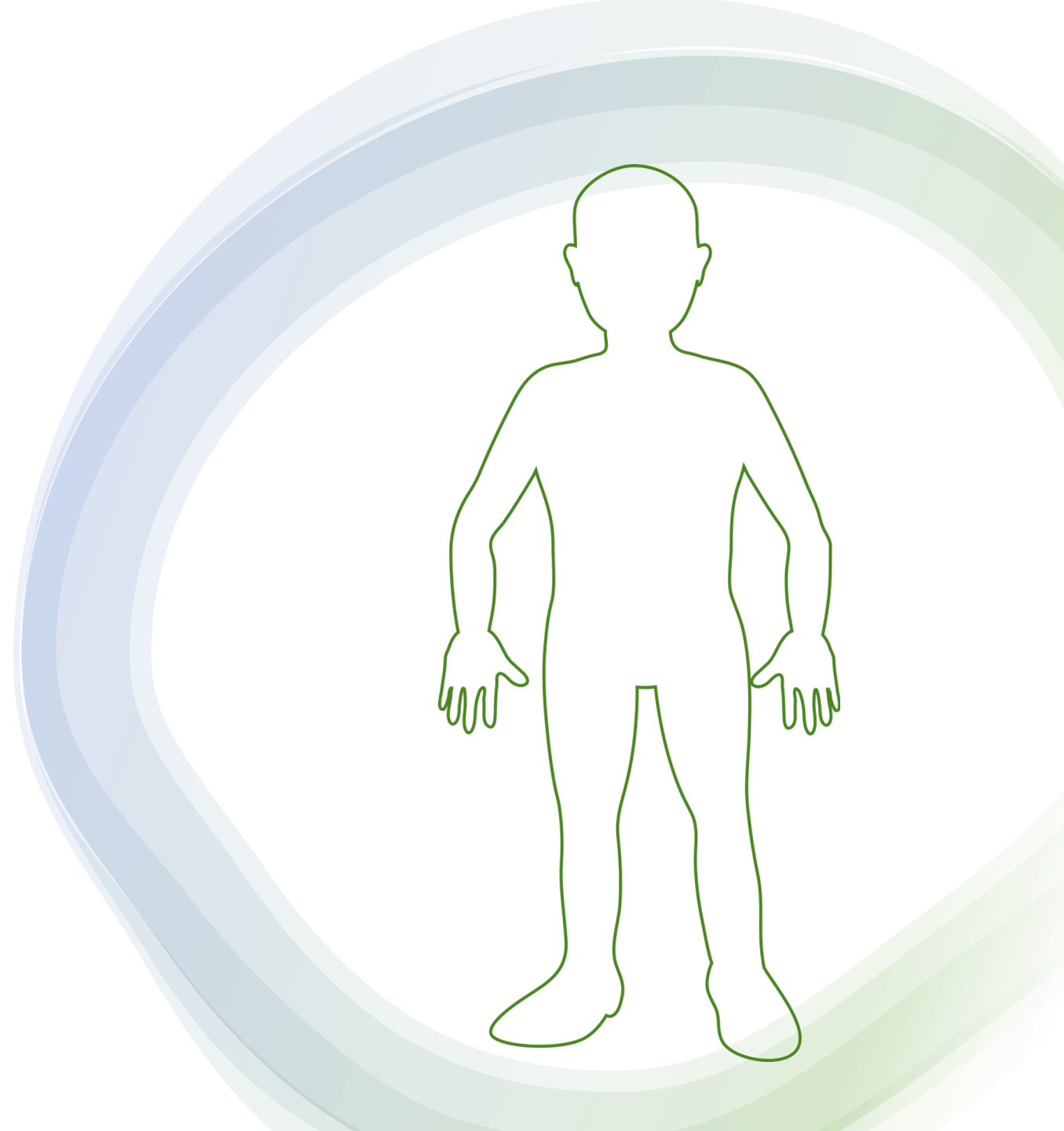
MEMORY VERSE

He used the human body as an example, but He was referring to the body of Christ – The multitude of believers!

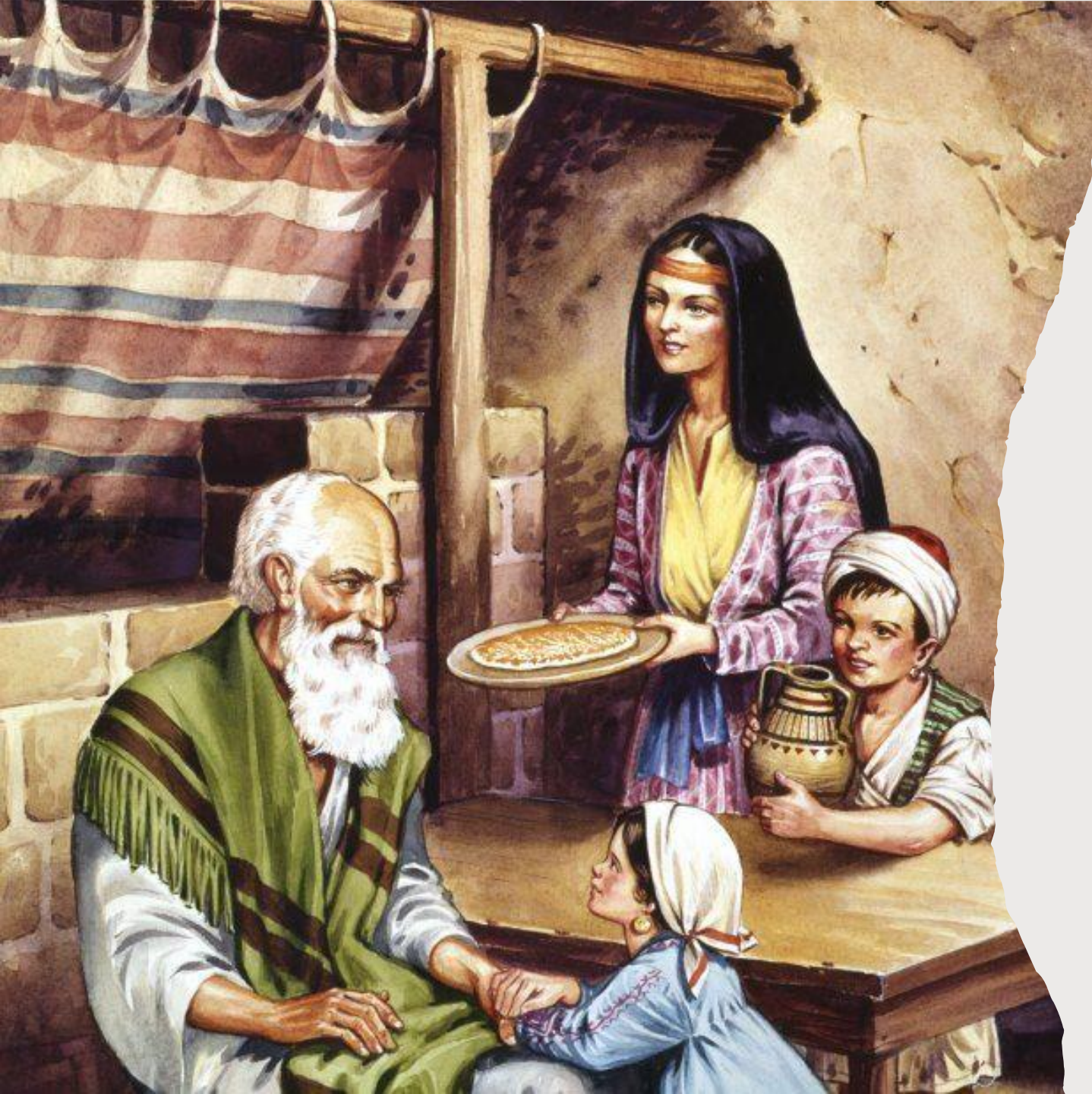


Almighty God created

Elisha 2 Kings 6:14-16

14 the king of Aram sent horses, chariots, and a great army. They went there by night and surrounded the city.

15 When the servant of the man of **God** got up and went out early in the morning an army with horses and chariots had surrounded the city. So he asked Elisha, "Oh my master, what are we to do?"

16 "Do not be afraid," Elisha answered, "for those who are with us are more than those who are with them."...



Gideon's ability was to hear the Lord and obey. And the Lord looked upon him and knew him for the man of faith and action that he was and said to him "*Go in this thy might, and thou shalt save Israel from the hand of the Midianites. I HAVE SENT THEE!*" (**Ch.6.14**).




