



When someone is nasty to you, Be nasty right back.


Say sorry for something wrong that you have done, but keep on doing it

God loves us and always wants to hear from us









Meaning of Diligence






We need to be careful, (diligent) So that sin does not grow and settle in our hearts








Don't Get Distracted






