

BRIDGEWATER CHURCH COVID-19 CAUTIONS

Please read our health and safety guidelines before entering the building.



SOCIAL DISTANCING: Six feet at all times.

Please practice social distancing while on the church campus. Stay several feet apart from others, except those who you have sheltered-in-place with.



FACE MASKS: Face masks are required.

It is required that you wear a facemask at all times in the building. If you are not ready to return to church with a mask, we lovingly invite you to continue worshipping with us online at home.



PHYSICAL CONTACT: No hugs, no handshakes, no high-fives.

Please do not touch others. We know this is very different, but limiting physical contact is essential.



HEALTH: Please come to church healthy.

Please take your temperature prior to entering the building. If you have recently felt sick, or you currently feel sick, we ask that you worship from home today.



GOOD HYGIENE: Sanitize and wash your hands often.

Sanitizing stations are set up around the building for your convenience and bathrooms are open for handwashing.



SANCTUARY SHELTER-IN-PLACE: Sit with those you live with.

We ask that you sit with the family members you have been sheltering in place with. Children and teens must stay with their parents or adult guardian at all times.



NO KIDS PROGRAMMING: Children must stay with their parents.

For the safety of our kids and families, children's programming will not be provided during this initial phase of reopening. We ask that young people remain with their adults during the entire time they are in the building.

If you feel that you are unable to adhere to these guidelines, we ask that you worship from home by streaming our service online.
