What: IYC is about LIFECHANGE

The convention itself is set up as a high impact week designed to take students and their relationships with God to a new level. Students will hear from world-class speakers, be led in worship from top Christian artists, develop deeper relationships with their peers, and experience life changing moments with God.

IYC 2021 REQUIREMENTS

In order for students to attend IYC 2021 in Orlando, FL, they must meet the following age and attendance requirements:

- Students must currently be in 7th through 12th grades.
- Students must attend a minimum of 20 Wednesday night gatherings between September 2020 and June 2021.
- This requirement will go into effect on Wednesday September 16th and go through June 23rd.
- Students are responsible for making sure they are checked-in upon arriving at each meeting.
- If BWC is not your child's home church, then 10 meetings must be met here, and 10 at their home church. Pastor Tyler will need signed documentation from a youth pastor/volunteer that 10 meetings were attended.

This requirement is designed to bring about unity and fully prepare students for their experience at IYC. Thus, a consistent attendance at youth gatherings and commitment to being involved in the lives of others in the group is needed in order to attend IYC next summer.

IYC 2021 SERVICE PROJECT/ CHURCH SPONSORSHIP

Estimated trip cost: \$1,100

In lieu of fundraising, BridgeWater Church has agreed to sponsor students to attend IYC next summer. The sponsored amount is \$200 and will be credited to the overall cost of the trip per student who meets the following requirements:

- From September 2019 through May 2020, each participant will need to serve in a minimum of 5 out of 9 service/community outreach projects in order to receive these funds.
- It is the student's responsibility to check-in upon arriving at each project.
- These funds will not be prorated or altered for any reason. You get the full credit for attending 5, no credit for attending less than 5.
- Due to Covid-19 safety guidelines outlined by BWC Pastors and Elders, we will be hosting our service projects onsite at BridgeWater Church during regularly scheduled gatherings at The Bridge. Keep an eye out for semester schedules so you can mark your calendars accordingly.
- Each student is allowed to complete 1 service project outside of The Bridge per semester (between September-December 2020 and January- May 2021) that can count as credit toward the overall requirement. Pastor Tyler will require documentation and a signed form from the leader of that ministry outreach. This can include but is not limited to: "All church" service projects, school organizations, community organizations, etc.
- *Note: this requirement need not be met in order to attend IYC. This is simply to get the extra help from church sponsorship. A student is permitted to attend and pay the full cost of the trip out of pocket.*

IYC 2021 PAYMENT PLAN

Estimated Trip Budget: You will have until Sunday, January 17th to sign-up for the trip, but are encouraged to sign up ASAP. After that date, trip openings will be closed. (Note: reservations are final after a non-refundable IYC registration has been paid- *due as first payment.*)
