6. Pray that God sends someone to lead them to Christ.

"Then he said to his disciples, 'The harvest is plentiful, but the laborers are few; therefore pray earnestly to the Lord of the harvest to send out laborers into his harvest.'" -Matthew 9:37-38

7. Pray that they believe in and confess Christ as Savior and Lord.

"Yet to all who received him, to those who believed in his name, he gave the right to become children of God." -1 John 1:12

"Truly, truly, I say to you, whoever hears my word and believes him who sent me has eternal life. He does not come into judgment, but has passed from death to life." -John 5:24

"....because, if you confess with your mouth that Jesus is Lord and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved."

-Romans 10:9-10

8. Pray that they take root and grow in Christ.

"...just as you have received Christ Jesus as Lord, continue to live in him, rooted and built up in him, strengthened in the faith as you are taught, and overflowing with thankfulness." -Deuteronomy 4:29

Read Genesis 12:1-3, Matthew 9:35-38 and Psalm 126:5-6.

Ask God to help you see people with the same concern, love and compassion that He has.
Ask God to help you identify five people in your live who likely do not have a personal relationship with Jesus Christ. Consider friends, relatives, acquaintances and neighbors. Record their names and pray regularly for their salvation.

1. Pray that Satan is bound from blinding them to the truth.
