FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS - PHASE 3

What is involved in Phase 3 (Starting October 4)?

- Worship services will be held on campus Sunday mornings at 9:00 AM and 10:30 AM.
- Worship services will be live streamed online Sunday mornings at 9:00 AM.
- Adult connect groups are able to meet on campus on Sunday morning.
- Student connect groups (6–12th grade) will meet during the 10:30 AM hour on Sundays.
- Preschool and kids ministry will be provided during the 10:30 AM Sunday service only.
- No Wednesday night programming will be offered on campus at this time.

Why are we making this transition now?

- As we've monitored the decline in new COVID-19 cases, especially with school back in session, we felt comfortable moving to this next phase which allows limited preschool and children's programming on campus.
- We believe making this transition now will position us to return to normal programming by January 2021.

Will everyone be required to wear a mask?

- Everyone age 6 and up must wear a mask indoors until they are seated, either in a worship service or connect group.
- For those people attending the 9:00 AM service, masks will no longer be required for the entire service. Participants may remove them once seated.
- All parents picking up and dropping off children are required to wear a mask.
- All family ministry volunteers (preschool, kids, and students) will wear masks throughout programming.

How will spaces be cleaned?

- The worship center and classrooms will continue to be set up with white plastic chairs, instead of cloth, so they can be easily sanitized.
- All chairs in the worship center will be completely wiped down by staff and volunteers between worship services.
- Any classrooms hosting connect groups both hours will be wiped down by the first group after their group dismisses.
- All spaces will be sanitized again after Sunday services.
- Surfaces frequently touched by multiple people, such as door handles, light switches, and faucets, will be cleaned and disinfected throughout the morning.

Family Ministry (Preschool, Kids, Students)

When will preschool/kids programming be offered?

- Preschool/kids programming will only be offered during the 10:30 AM service on Sunday morning.
- KidsROCK will be offered for kids in Kindergarten through 3rd grade, with a special connect group provided for 4-5th graders.
- Nothing will be provided on Thursday nights or during the 9:00 AM Sunday service.

What protocols are being following for children attending preschool/kids programming?

- All parents checking children in will be asked to indicate verbally that they are following the illness policy.
- All children will have their temperature checked at check in. Anyone with a temperature
 of 100.4°F or above will be asked to step aside and be re-checked. If the elevated
 temperature is confirmed with a second check, all household members will be asked to
 attend virtually.
- All adults, including parents, must wear a mask while in the preschool/kids building (no exceptions).
- Everyone entering the preschool or kids hallways will be asked to sanitize their hands.
- Only one parent may enter the preschool or kids hallways to pick up children in order to minimize traffic.

When will student connect groups be offered?

- Student connect groups will only be offered during the 10:30 AM service on Sunday morning.
- As we expect the transition back to in-person activities to happen gradually, we will host four student CGs initially: middle school boys, middle school girls, high school boys, and high school girls.
- Once attendance rebounds, we will add additional classes as necessary.

If someone in my child's class tests positive for COVID-19, will I be notified?

• If your child has direct contact and/or prolonged exposure with someone who tests positive, you will be notified, but no personal or identifying information will be given.

Is there a way my family can help as we begin to re-open preschool and children's programming?
