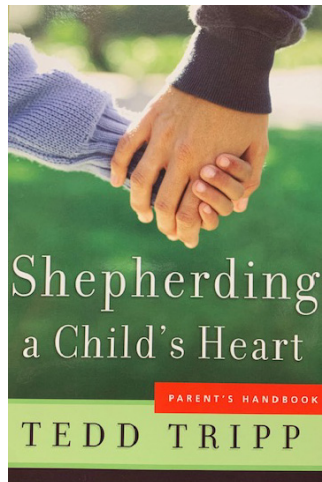
An Intensive Approach to Men's Discipleship
