This includes teaching in Perspectives classes around the country for the past 34 years. He regularly visits Vietnam to do leadership development and teach on missions to house church pastors as well as preaching and teaching in American churches. Since 2008, Dave and his wife Kathy have served as full time mission mobilizers. They are currently on staff with Frontier Ventures (formerly the U.S. Center for World Mission) in Pasadena, CA. While they mobilize anywhere that they are invited, their focus is on the northeast region of the US (Virginia through Maine). Dave and Kathy will celebrate their 53nd wedding anniversary in June 2021. They have lived in Catonsville, MD, for 24 years. They have three married children, Dan, Mike, and Becky and are the proud grandparents of 11 grandchildren.


#### **BASM AUDITORIUM**

VSN initiatives include the Mobile Ministry Forum, the Middle East Women's Leadership Network, Mission Media U, the Augmented & Virtual Reality Network and Empower Women Media. Before this, he oversaw new media development for Jesus Film Project and coordinated the campus work of Cru throughout North Africa, the Middle East and Central Asia. Clyde holds a Bachelor of Science degree from the University of Maryland/College Park and a Master of Divinity / Missiology degree with honors from Denver Seminary.
