



Stand beside her

And guide her

To the right with the light from above

Make her victorious on land and foam

God Bless America, my home sweet home. Berlin knew he had to change the line To the right with the light from above. "The Right" in politics had come to mean conservative political groups. He wanted a song that brought Americans together, not set Americans apart. And he changed Make her victorious ... since it suggested military conquest, rather than the "peace song" he was shooting for. The result was the song most American school kids have learned by heart ever since.

To the prairies,


To the ocean white with foam

Smith sang the song as the show closer on her live national broadcast that night. Berlin's phone immediately began ringing off the hook. Everyone wanted to know where they could get the music. It became Smith's trademark.

As a child, my sister and I would put our little "red" record on our record player and sing right along with Kate Smith with lots of enthusiasm, hands on our heart, and pride in our country—the United States of America!
