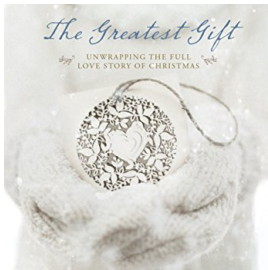


Advent Reading

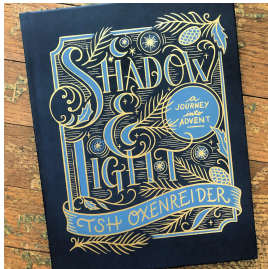

for men and women

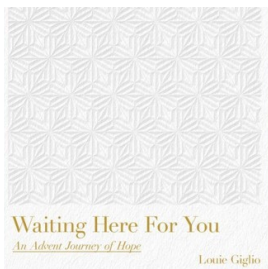
