Thanksgiving Meals

In 2008, the first year of Vintage Church, we provided Thanksgiving meals to a handful of families at Randleman High School who otherwise would not have had a meal. Fast forward thirteen years to Thanksgiving 2021: VC paired your generosity with our amazing partners at Run 5 Feed 5, Foster Caviness, Triad Meat Company, and Coke to serve families in every school in the Randolph County School district and Uwharrie Charter Academy, along with families referred to us by people here at Vintage Church. On Tuesday night, November 23, we witnessed 286 volunteers as they delivered complete thanksgiving meals to almost two thousand people in our community. Under the leadership of Jessi Green and her team, this Thanksgiving Meal Initiative was our best yet, and we are prayerful and hopeful about what God will let us do next to Serve our City.

Women's Weekend

"Women's Community Group is a gift to each woman who walks through the door on Thursday nights. One of the most significant areas of growth we witnessed last year is that women are picking up their Bibles to read it with confidence. Increasing Biblical literacy is breathing life into an area where women have expressed disqualification, misunderstanding, or just a lack of direction. Our weekly conversation around understanding the story of God and taking our time to read and discuss the Gospels in 2021 laid the groundwork for interest in reading through the Bible in 2022. We currently have over fifty-five women actively engaging in The Bible Recap reading plan!

The past few years have left people feeling isolated and disconnected, so for many women the highlight of the year was Women's Weekend. Sixty-one women gathered at Victory Mountain Camp for a weekend of abundant connection and learning to be On Mission. Women leaders within VC engaged those gathered in powerful sessions of learning, prayer, vulnerability and worship. The presence of God over us that weekend was tangible. The fruit from the weekend was both immediate and on-going: friendships created and restored, hope gained, connections made, testimonies shared, freedom in honesty, women being seen, and a deeper desire to spend time with Jesus."
