## DISCUSS

What temptations did the recipients of the letter the Hebrews encounter (2:1; 3:12-13; 4:1, 11; 5:11; 6:1; 10:32-39)?

What is the main message about Jesus in this letter, and how should it provide hope amid temptations (1:1-4; 2:9, 17-18; 3:1, 5; 4:14-16; 5:7-10)?

How does God guarantee the promises he makes (6:13-16) and how do we know that he won't retract his promise (6:18)?

How is Jesus the link between God's promises and your life today (6:19-20)?

## APPLY

What problems or troubles currently threaten your sense of security?

What promises of God give you hope in the midst of these troubles?

In what ways are you tempted to doubt God's promises?

How does Jesus keep you anchored to God's promises when the storms rage?

What steps can you take over the coming week to put your sense of security in Christ?
