- What it is for
 - Rainy-day events
 - Unexpected expenses


- What it is NOT for
 - Known, planned expenses
 - Knowable, plan-able expenses
 - Discretionary spending

- Where to get the money?
 - Monthly budget
 - Sell something
 - Work extra hours

- How to make an Emergency Fund
 - Open a separate savings account
 - Don't allow overdraft protection
 - Keep it safe
 - Keep it liquid

- Use your Emergency Fund
 - Make a plan
 - Replenish your fund
