Title: But God Remembers

Text: Genesis 8:1

Big Idea: There are times when we may feel overwhelmed and forgotten, but God remembers and rescues his people according to his kindness and grace.

REVIEW THE SERMON

How does the “but God” in Genesis 8:1 function as the central point of the entire story of Noah and the flood?

What does the record of the flood in Genesis 6-9 tell us about the nature of man and character of God.

APPLY THE TRUTH

Under what circumstances are you prone to believe that God has forgotten you? Why?

Based on His promises, how might God’s version of deliverance differ from yours? How are you tempted to change His promises to fulfill your desires?

When God does not deliver the way you think He should, how do you respond?

Where do you need to put to death ungodly reactions and cling to the promises of God instead?

How does 2 Peter 1:3-4 encourage you to use the promises of God? Share together some “precious and very great promises.”

COMMIT THIS WEEK

Find one promise of God that directly combats a lie you are tempted to believe during times of trial. Write it down, review, and ask the Lord for the grace to believe it and change.
