What is the Bible?


DEFINITION CONTINUED

...The Bible is comprised of 66 books, divided into two testaments, and written by over 40 authors spanning almost 1,500 years. It reveals to God's people the unifying history of God's redeeming words and acts.

The ultimate focus of Scripture is the incarnation and redemptive work of Jesus Christ. He is the center to which everything in Scripture is united and bound together—beginning and end, creation and redemption, humanity, the world, the fall, history, and the future.”






TEXTUAL CRITICISM


