
WHAT IS THE CHURCH?

Definition:

"The church is the people of God who have been saved through repentance and faith in the				
gospel of Jesus Christ and incorporated into his body through baptism with the Holy Spirit. It				
consists of two interrelated elements: the church and the church. The				
universal church becomes manifested in local churches characterized by being doxological,				
logocentric, pneumadynamic, covenantal, and missional.				
Local churches are led by pastors (or elders) and served by deacons, possess and pursue purity				
and unity and exercise In terms of its mission, the church regularly				
gathers to worship the triune God, proclaim his Word, celebrate the of baptism				
and the Lord's Supper, engage non-Christians with the gospel, exercise spiritual gifts, disciple				
their members, care for people through prayer and giving."
