### TOTAL DEPRAVITY DOES NOT MEAN

That we are worthless.

That we are as bad as we could be.

That we are incapable of virtue from a human perspective.

### TOTAL DEPRAVITY DOES MEAN

That sin has affected every aspect our being, and that in and of ourselves, we are in a state of inability, contributing nothing to our return and reconciliation with God.

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• "elect" (1 Peter 1:1; 2 Timothy 2:10; Titus 1:1; Romans 8:33; Matthew 24:31)

• "chosen" (Colossians 3:12; 1 Peter 2:9)

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- It speaks of God's predetermined plan. (Acts 4:27–28)
- It also speaks of the goal or the destination for those who have been chosen. (Romans 8:29–30)
