REVIEW THE SERMON
We often think of evangelism and missions as New Testament concepts. In what ways does Psalm 67
function as a song for global mission?
What's the difference between having a head knowledge of God and having a heart knowledge of him? What are the dangers of having a view of God that's all head no heart, and a view that's all heart no head?
ASSESS YOUR LIFE
Theology (To Know Him) - What keeps you from growing in the grace and knowledge a of God (2 Peter 3:18). What helps you flourish?
Missiology (To Make Him Known) – What makes you excited to talk to others about Jesus? What are some of the biggest hindrances to personal evangelism in your life?
Doxology (To Bring Him Praise) – How does knowing God and making him known fuel your personal and corporate worship?
APPLY THE TRUTH
Think of some of your weaknesses. How does the desire to see people come to know God's saving power shape your view of those weaknesses? How have you seen God use your weaknesses to exalt his power before the eyes of others (Cf. Deut. 7:6-11; 9:4-6; 1 Cor. 1:26-31)?

What are you going to do this week that will help you cultivate an intimate relationship with Christ? Be specific. Don't wing it. Decide and stick with it!
