3. What is the main promise in v. 28? How do vs. 29-30 relate to the promise of v. 28?
4. In your own words, summarize Paul's conclusion in vs. 31-39? Based on what Paul says, what do you think his listeners might be struggling with as the chapter comes to an end?
5. How does it make you feel to know that God is *for you*? (v. 31). Describe an area of your life where you are tempted to doubt that promise? How does God show you that he is still for you even though you're struggling to believe?
6. What does Paul mean when he says that Christians are *more than conquerors*? (v. 37). Describe how this practically applies in an area of temptation, doubt, or difficulty (cf. John 16:33; 1 Cor. 15:57).
7. Why do the promises in vs. 31-39 give you hope in the midst of all your failures and difficulties?
