# Grace Point Kids Medical Center COVID Reopening Plan

#### **General Overview**

- Four (4) rooms open in the Main Building during the 11:30am service only.
- Room 1 is for 4<sup>th</sup> & 5<sup>th</sup> grade.
- Room 2 is for Kinder-3<sup>rd</sup> grade.
- Room 4 is for 2-4 year olds.
- Room 5 is for under 2.
- Rooms 1, 2, and 4 have a maximum of 8 kids per room.
- Room 5 (babies) has a maximum of 6 kids.
- There is a minimum of 2 background-checked GPK volunteers per room with at least one female volunteer in each room.

#### **Practicing Social Distancing**

- Children Kinder-5<sup>th</sup> grade will sit 6 feet apart at designated spots at tables.
- Volunteers will remind children to remain 6 feet apart while in the classroom.
- Signs displaying non-contact forms of interacting are posted in each room.
- Social distancing reminders are also posted in the Kids area.
- Social distance markers are placed on the floor at check-in for parents.

## **Cleaning & Disinfecting**

- Hand sanitizer is available in each room. Kids must sanitize their hands upon entering the classrooms.
- Proper hand-washing signs are posted in all bathrooms and above all sinks.
- Tissues are available in each room and must be thrown away immediately after use.
- All adults and children Kinder-5<sup>th</sup> grade must wear masks.
- Adults in rooms 4 & 5 must wear a face mask and face shield.
- Kinder-5<sup>th</sup> grade will not be allowed to bring outside items like food, drinks, or bags unless they have a written doctor's note.
- Clorox wipes are available in each room for volunteers to wipe down hard surface items.
- Rooms are sanitized before and after each use.
- Only GPK volunteers and children are allowed in the classrooms. No parents.

### **Modified Check-in**

- A COVID waiver form (required once) and COVID screening form (required weekly) must be completed prior to accepting children in classrooms. Both forms are available at gracepoint.org/parentresources.
- Parents may also complete the COVID forms via printed QR codes available at check-in.

• Only a GPK volunteer may touch the check-in computer. A volunteer will check-in the child and parents will receive the printed security tags. Parents must present their security tags to volunteers at pick up.

## **Screening Procedures**

- All GPK volunteers have updated background checks.
- All GPK volunteers must complete the weekly COVID screening form
