Living Springs 7 Day Prayer Guide



Pray for God's vision and direction for Living Springs

Write down the revelation and make it plain on tablets so that a herald may run with it. For the revelation awaits an appointed time; it speaks of the end and will not prove false. Though it linger, wait for it, it will certainly come and will not delay. **Habakkuk 2:2-3**

Prayer: Lord, we pray for your vision for our church to come to pass. I pray that you would speak to us personally, so that the vision would align with yours. We pray that you would reveal and confirm the plans you have for us. We thank you Lord that you want to speak to us and we commit to walking out your vision in our lives. God, we thank you that your vision for my life, my family, our leaders, our church and this world is for this appointed time. Amen.

2. Pray for our leaders to hear and be led by the Lord

For this reason, since the day we heard about you, we have not stopped praying for you. We continually ask God to fill you with the knowledge of his will through all the wisdom and understanding that the Spirit gives **Colossians 1:9**

Prayer: Lord, I pray for our Pastors and leaders, and their families. I pray they would receive revelation and illumination from the Bible and the Holy Spirit; that God's vision and plans for Living Springs would become vivid. Lord, I pray that you would speak to our leaders. I pray that they would be sensitive to hear and then walk in faith according to what you've spoken. I pray for clarity and understanding as the vision is communicated, and that we (the church) would fully embrace it. I pray that Living Springs leaders would have unity of mind and purpose and that our pastors would be blessed in every way as they give their lives to see your vision come to pass. Amen.



Pray for Courage to do what the Lord has called us to do

Be strong and courageous. Do not be afraid or terrified because of them, for the Lord your God goes with you; he will never leave you nor forsake you. **Deuteronomy 31:6**

Prayer: Lord, I pray for our church to walk with courage in whatever direction you call us. When we would draw back, please remind me us who YOU are, and who we are in You. You are strong and courageous, the Almighty King and loving Father. You have said in Your word that as we wait upon You, we can "take courage," because we know You are with us, You are for us, and You will empower us with the courage we need for whatever is placed before us. Remind us of who You have created us to be and what You have empowered us to do. Amen.

4. Prayer for the unity of our congregation

Therefore if you have any encouragement from being united with Christ, if any comfort from his love, if any common sharing in the Spirit, if any tenderness and compassion, then make my joy complete by being like-minded, having the same love, being one in spirit and of one mind.

Philippians 2:1-2

Prayer: God of Mercy and Love, You direct our steps in everything. We bring to You Living Springs Community Church and where it stands. We know that you have a great purpose for our church in this community and we know unity is needed for that purpose to be fulfilled. Without You to bring that unity, everything will fall apart. 5. Prayer for God to provide for us

And my God will supply every need of yours according to his riches in glory in Christ Jesus. **Philipians 4:19**

Prayer: Dear God, You are Jehovah-Jireh, the God who provides. We thank you that you own it all and hold everything in your hands. We thank you that you know our needs before we even ask. Thank you for the abundance of blessing and goodness you have poured out on us. We love you Lord; we're leaning on you. In Jesus' name, Amen.

Pray for God to send revival to the church and community

Will you not revive us again, that your people may rejoice in you? Psalm 85:6

Prayer: Father, today we come together as true and sincere followers of You to kindly and ardently ask for a revival in our land, our community, and in our church. Father, You say in Matthew 7 to come and ask You as our Father for what we desire. Lord, we desire for our friends, families, and neighbors to be open and to seek and find the truth of the authentic source of life- You. We invite You, Holy Spirit to pour out onto the people You have made. We invite You to perform miracles, wonders, and to speak to the people You crafted with Your hands. Lord would you send revival and start with your church. Help us God to be a light in the darkness that points all to you, no matter what. In Jesus' name. Amen

7. Prayer for God's will to be done

Now may the God of peace, who through the blood of the eternal covenant brought back from the dead our Lord Jesus, that great Shepherd of the sheep, equip you with everything good for doing his will, and may he work in us what is pleasing to him, through Jesus Christ, to whom be glory for ever and ever. Amen. **Hebrews 13:20-21**
