Micro Churches

COVID-19 and the related Shelter in Place order and ban on public gatherings have reminded us just how much we crave and need relationships. At Living Springs Community Church, we value relationships among our brothers and sisters in Christ. As reopening begins in Illinois, we realize that God is giving us a unique time not only to continue worshiping and serving Him, but also to gather and grow in new ways. One of those ways is through Micro Churches.

Q: What is a Micro Church?

A: This is simply a gathering of believers outside of the traditional Sunday morning "Church Service".

Q: What does a Micro Church look like?

A: It can take on a number of shapes:

- Your family
- Your small group or Bible study group
- Friends who agree to watch the worship service – together or separately – and come together to discuss it.
 - "come together" in person or on the phone or on a digital platform like Zoom or Facetime or Google Hangouts, etc.
 - "discuss it" – Utilize the Sermon discussion guide to help you talk about what you learned from the message and how you can apply it to your life.

Q: How do I create this Micro Church?

A: Here are a few simple steps:

1. Make a decision to create this type of group.
2. Invite others - friends, neighbors, family members, believers, non-believers - to be a part of your group.
3. Watch and discuss the Sunday message.
 - a. Download and use the Sermon Discussion Guide to help you talk about the message.
